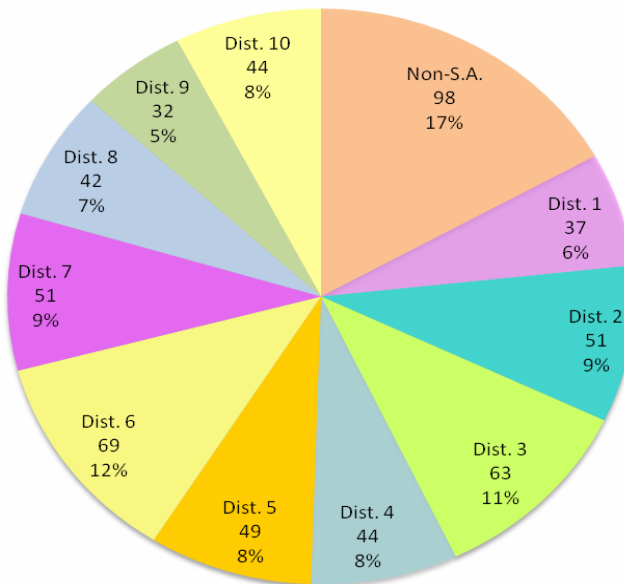

Students Served

580 participants served, which directly impacted 1,665 family members.

400 participants (included in the number above) carried over from the 2006 – 2007 program year.

Graduates

198 people have graduated from Project QUEST with the tools to embark upon new opportunities to improve the quality of life for themselves, their families, and our economy.

Earnings

181 participants placed in this program year earned an average of \$9,200 in the year before they entered QUEST training. After graduation and job placement, they are on track to earn an average of \$39,000 per year.
